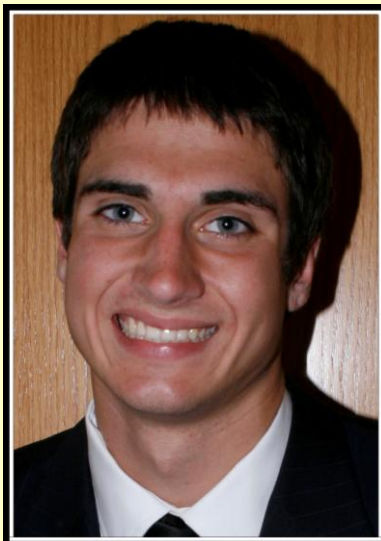


Congratulations Congratulations
