Honoring Henry Jordan, a noted Warwick class of 1953 student athlete and former All-Pro NFL player, this scholarship is presented annually to one student who "must excel in academics, citizenship, and athletics." Jessica M. Fry is the 2011 honoree of this award. Jessica has excelled in her International Baccalaureate program at Warwick High School, earning an unweighted 3.64 GPA and an overall weighted GPA of 4.22. She is ranked 13<sup>th</sup> in her class of 340.

Volunteerism is important to Jessica, and she has served nearly 800 hours of community service while working a part-time job. The organization she has been most active in is the USO, supporting soldiers and their families. In the last five years, she has volunteered over 500 hours of her time. Additionally she organized a relief fundraiser following the earthquake in Haiti in 2010, has interned at KingsWay Physical Therapy, and has over 50 hours of participation with the Young Life Club. She enjoys organizing collection drives for many causes, including books for a foster home, toiletries for a battered women's shelter, and a fundraiser for a local teen cancer patient.

At school, Jessica's athletic prowess is evident as a member of the Varsity Cross Country team, Varsity Swim team, and Captain of the Varsity Soccer team. Additionally, she serves as President of the IB Student Advisory Board, President of the Math Honor Society, Treasurer of the Hispanic Honor Society, and a member of the National Honor Society. She is the recipient of an AP Scholar Award and placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> (respectively) in the School, City, and Tidewater Regional Science Fairs. Jessica plays the piano, dabbles in guitar, and hopes to compose her own music someday.

Her IB English teacher calls Jessica a "gifted and exceptional student" with "character and enthusiasm." She is described as "a remarkable human being in every sense of the word" by her IB Counselor. In particular, her "empathy for the human race" is noted. Jessica is the embodiment of this scholarship's criteria.
